PURPOSE:

To adopt a policy regarding the Association's procedures for handling

conflicts of interest involving Directors

AUTHORITY:

The Declaration, Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Association

and Colorado law.

EFFECTIVE

RESOLUTION:

The Association hereby adopts the following Policy and Procedures:

- 1. A conflict of interest involving a Director exists when a Director engages in a conflicting interest transaction.
- 2. A conflicting interest transaction means: A contract, transaction, or other financial relationship between the Association and a Director of the Association or between the Association and a party related to a Director, or between the Association and an entity in which a Director of the Association is a board member, director or officer or has a financial interest.
- 3. A "party related to a Director" shall mean a spouse, a descendent, an ancestor, a sibling, the spouse or descendent of a sibling, an estate or trust in which the Director or a party related to a Director has a beneficial interest or an entity in which a party related to a Director is a board member, officer, or has a financial interest.
- 4. No loans shall be made by the Association to a Director. Any Director who assents to or participates in the making of any such loan shall be liable to the Association for the amount of such loan until the repayment thereof.
- 5. When a conflict of interest exists, the conflict must be reported to the Executive Board as soon as is reasonably possible.
- 6. The Director must recuse himself or herself from discussing or voting on the issue.
- 7. The Executive Board shall review the Association's conflict of interest policies, procedures, and rules and regulations every two years.
