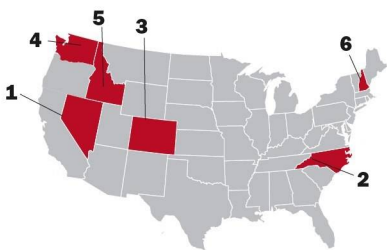


This week: Homes bordering national forests

1 **Carson City, Nev.** Clear Creek Tahoe is surrounded by 6 million-acre Humboldt-Toiyabe, the largest national forest in the continental United States. This house, built there in 2018, features high ceilings, walnut kitchen cabinets, two master suites, and a gas fireplace. Outside are a balcony, a living area with firepit, ski storage, and access to overnight cottages, a golf course, and the Lake and Ski House. \$3,195,000. 2 **Blowing Rock, N.C.** Kallalanta, “Heavenly View,” sits on 10.3 acres between two national forests on the Eastern Continental Divide in the Blue Ridge Mountains. The 1914 five-bedroom home has ornate woodwork, stone fireplaces, and screened porches on two levels. The property includes a guesthouse, old-growth rhododendron, and a large oak. 3 **Steamboat Springs, Colo.**

This five-bedroom contemporary home abuts the Medicine Bow–Routt National Forests and is five minutes’ drive from Steamboat Ski Resort. The house features a 30-foot ceiling, a double-sided steel fireplace, floor-to-ceiling windows, energy-efficient construction, and a main bedroom with spa bathroom.
